President's Ponderings



Guild Members,

I wish we were hearing better news related to the COVID-19 outbreak. The library has not opened the Community Room and your board feels the health risks are still too high to gather in one place. As an alternative, we want to try a ZOOM Guild Meeting for July. It is the only option for now other than cancelling again.

If this technology makes you a little uncomfortable, I encourage you to give it a try! We have setup a TEST ZOOM Meeting on Tuesday, July 7th, at

7PM. The purpose of this meeting is to give you a chance to get more familiar with ZOOM and how to connect with your device of choice (computer, laptop, tablet, or phone). If you have already used ZOOM, there is no need to connect on Tuesday unless you want more practice.

For ZOOM meetings, I recommend clicking the meeting link about 5-10 minutes before the meeting starts. If you have not used ZOOM before, the software will automatically download and install on your device. The meeting is setup with an ID and password, but it should automatically be entered for you. Next you will be asked to identify your microphone and camera to be used for audio and video. Once successfully connected, you will be placed in a 'waiting room' until the meeting Host accepts your logon. Note ALL members will enter the meeting on mute to help us manage the conversation in this larger group. You will have a "raise your hand" feature available to you that is monitored by the Host and Co-host so we can unmute your microphone so everyone can hear you.

Our July ZOOM Guild Meeting is on Thursday, July 9th at 7PM. That is maybe a little sooner that you were expecting as the first day of July falls on a Thursday. There is no program scheduled for July. The agenda will start with a brief update of some guild activities since we last met in March and a look at our current financials. After any questions from the group, we will have Show & Tell. Have your items to share close at hand and we will call on each of you one at a time.

You will receive a reminder email from Elaine Stoecker two days before each of these meetings. They will contain the actual meeting link for your use.

We have not had a ZOOM meeting with over 10 people so far. Please bear with us as we work through the mechanics of managing a larger number of participants. I look forward to seeing many of you online at our July Guild Meeting!





SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE

This local San Antonio Charity makes beds and donates them to families who have children sleeping on the floor in San Antonio. Our motto is: No Child Sleeps on the Floor in Our Town!

The beds are standard twin size and we make beds that are stackable, so they could be made into bunk beds.

This organization started in 2012 in Twin Falls, Idaho and now it is spreading nation wide. The San Antonio Chapter just started and had their first build on April 21, 2018, where we made 19 bunk beds, or a total of 38 single beds. The San Antonio Chapter currently has applications for 700 beds. That is a total of 350 bunk beds that have been requested. **The need is real.** We made a total of 165 bunk beds in 2018. Any quilt donation would be greatly appreciated!

We are in need of twin size quilts for these beds. The recipients are ages 3-17 years old. The approx size we are looking for is 60" x 80". Anything close to this size would be prefect.

Would you as a member of The Cibolo Creek Quilt Guild consider this local charity as an organization you would donate a quilts to?

Mike Rowe does a facebook series called *Returning the Favor*. He featured this charity in Feburary, 2018. Since this program has aired there have been 500 towns that have requested to open a chapter. This is the link to watching that show.
