I'd fly up to visit with my Singer Featherweight carry-on (it really does fit under the seat in front of you). I'd ask if she wanted to sew a minute and she always said "If you think I can help you."!

I have just a few small quilts I was able to make with Mom but memories to last me a lifetime.






## Raffle Quilt 2021 - 2022
