Even with the sunshine that Thursday, there were some brisk winds blowing. We collected a large rag quilt, Quilt of Honor tops and pillowcases, activity mats, wheelchair quilts, prayer shawls, several baby blankets AND filled 5 buckets with food, tolitaries and toys for Hill Country Family Services. And when you top that off with 100 stocking for HCCA completed and returned, we had another amazing donation drop-off event thanks to all of you! It seemed like an almost impossible task with a tight schedule to get 135 stocking completed for distribution this December.

Kelly set us up for success by designing a simple to sew stocking pattern, cutting ALL 270 stocking pieces and bunding them into 10 stocking kit packs. We only have two more groups of 10 to collect and that donation will be complete. Way to go ladies!

- You can send digital pictures of your show and tell to Bonnie a few days prior to the meeting. She will post them during your presentation.


