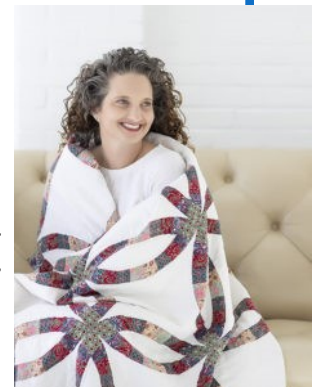
Quilt 2 End ALZ Zoom Workshop
