

Poinsettia Table Topper / Wall Quilt

Kathy Groves - Zoom Class

Supplies needed:

- Pattern: Quiltworx Poinsettia Pattern (included with registration) and Fabrics
- 6" or 12" Add-A-Quarter Ruler
- 12" 18" Ruler
- Fabric Glue Pen (small diameter) water soluble
- Flower Pins or Magic Pins (you'll love these!)
- 1 Box of Jumbo Paper Clips
- Purple Thang or Quilter's Awl
- 4 Gallon sized Zip closed bags
- Microtex Sharp Needles (size 70) suggested
- Medium sized cutting mat (18" x 24")
- Rotary Cutter with new blade
- Sewing machine with BOTH open toe and 1/4" sewing feet
- Regular sewing supplies

Also not required but suggested:

- Easy Press Pen (not the same thing as the glue pens.) with solution (sold separately.)
- Repositional Glue Stick

Fabric Requirements: (You have MANY options depending upon how many different fabrics you wish to use. I can make up a couple of different fabric kits if you are interested. Email me if you would like more information on those. We can also do a Quiltster Consultation – but this one is pretty straightforward.
