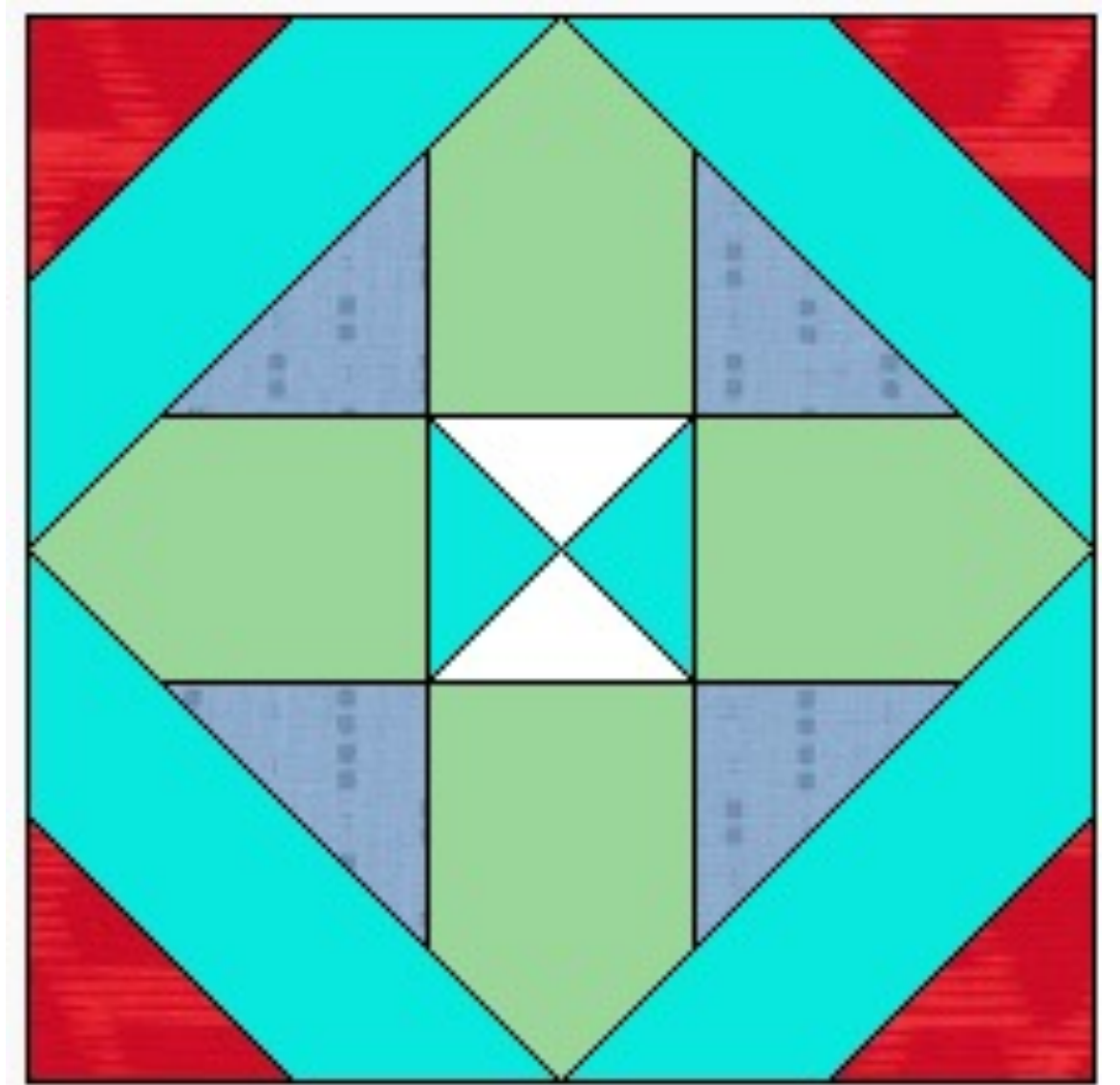

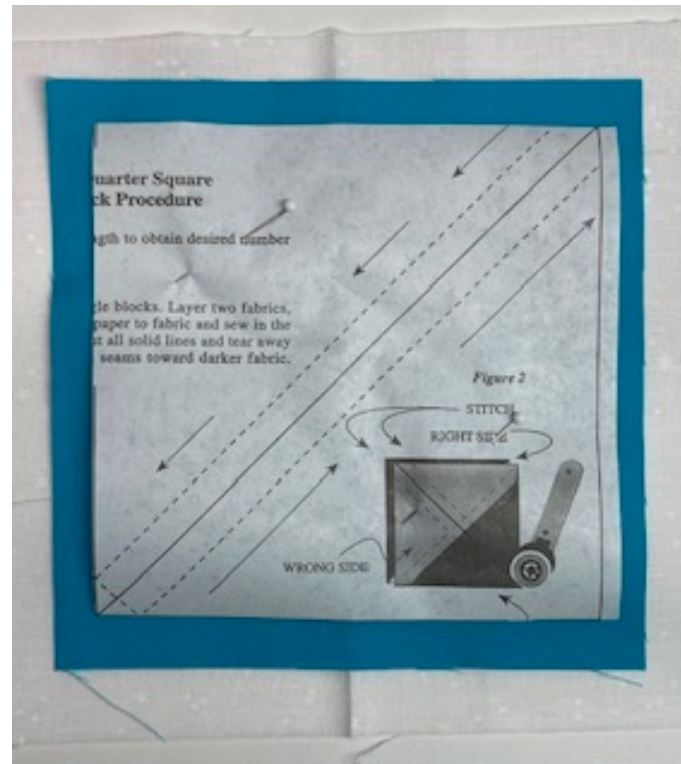
Cutting Instructions:

- A. Light blue: (8) 5" squares.
- B. Light green: (8) 3 1/2"x 5" rectangles
- C. Dark aqua: (1) 5" square.
- D. White: (1) 5" square.
- E. Aqua (light or dark): (8) 6 1/2" squares
- F. Red: (8) 3" squares.

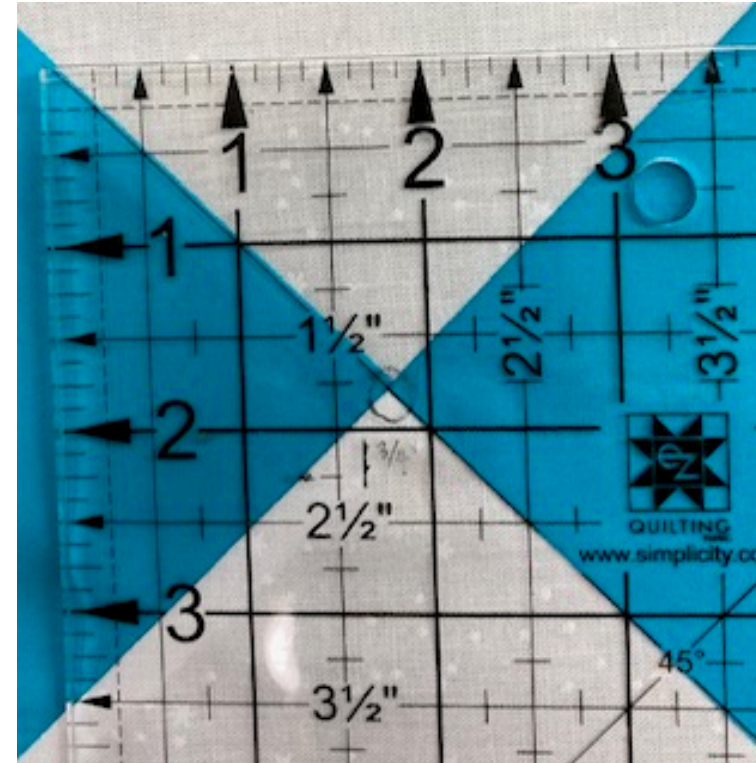
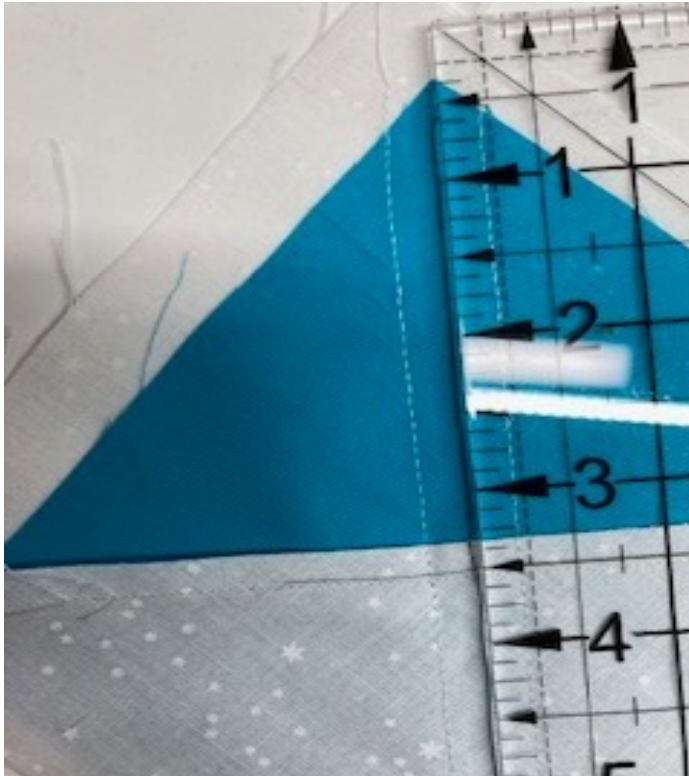
Construction:

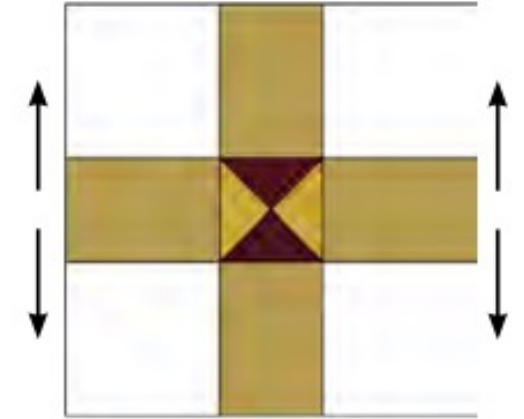
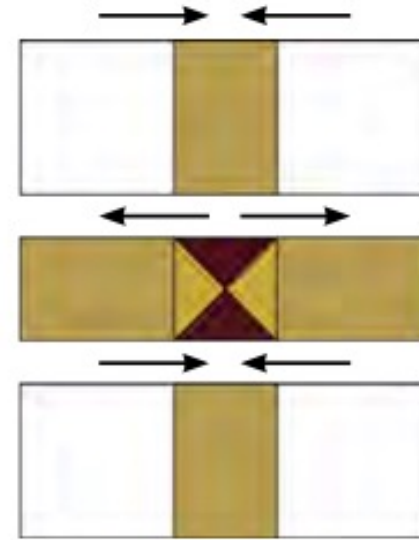
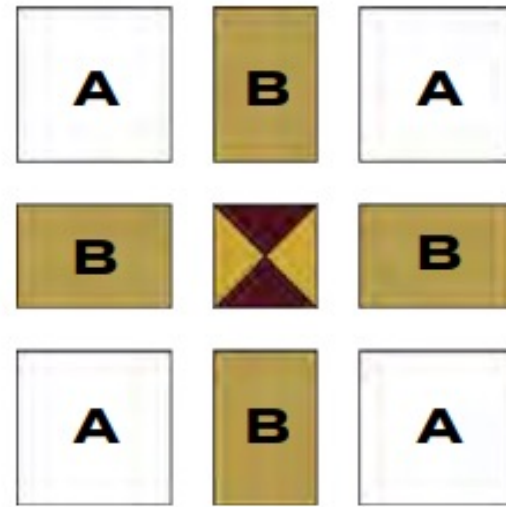
1. Center Quarter Square Triangle (QST): use the "Triangles On a Roll" 3" Finished Square paper grid provided. First make HST by layering the dark aqua and white 5" square fabrics RST and pin the paper on top. Reduce the machine stitch length to 1.5 and sew along the arrows and then cut along the diagonal solid line. Do not cut the outside edges. Return the stitch length to the regular setting. Tear the paper away and press to the aqua. Place these two squares RST with the white half on top of the aqua half. Draw a line on the diagonal crossing the seams and sew 1/4" away on both sides. Cut on the line and press to the side. Square up to 3 1/2". These will be the centers for both blocks.
2. Complete the 12" block using the Assembly Instructions from Moda, starting at line 3.

- Center Quarter Square Triangle (QST): use the **“Triangles On a Roll” 3” Finished Square** paper grid provided. First make HST by layering the dark aqua and white 5”square fabrics RST and pin the paper on top. Reduce the machine stitch length to 1.5 and sew along the arrows and then cut along the diagonal solid line. Do not cut the outside edges. Return the stitch length to the regular setting. Tear the paper away and press to the aqua.



1. Place these two squares RST with the white half on top of the aqua half. Draw a line on the diagonal crossing the seams and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away on both sides. Cut on the line and press to the side. Square up to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". These will be the centers for both blocks.

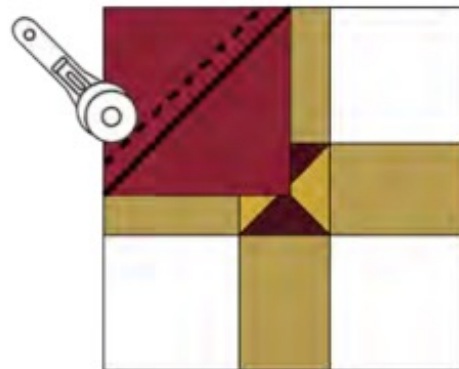
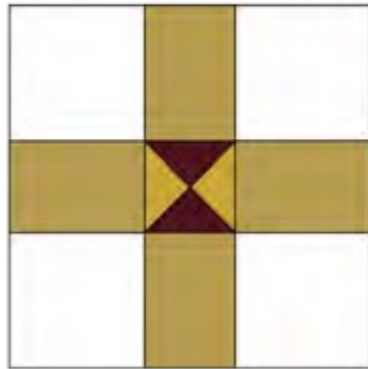




3. Place (1) QST unit, (4) A squares and (4) B rectangles as shown in the diagram.
4. Sew units together, pressing seams toward the B rectangles.



6. Place (1) E square with a drawn diagonal line on opposite corners of the block as shown.
7. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines.
8. Trim outermost excess fabric to $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and press to the corner.
9. Repeat stitch and flip techniques on both remaining block corners to complete stitch and flip techniques with E squares.

10. Repeat stitch and flip techniques using (4) F squares, each with a drawn diagonal line. Stitch and flip each corner of the block to complete block assembly.
