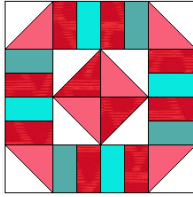


## BLOCK 5: Cross Roads Block from EQ8



### Cutting Instructions:

From red, cut (2) 4" squares and (4) 2" x 15" rectangles.

From peach, cut (6) 4" squares.

From white, cut (8) 4" squares.

From dark aqua, cut (2) 2" x 15" rectangles.

From light aqua, cut (2) 2" x 15" rectangles.

### Construction:

1. On the back of all the 4" white squares, draw a line from corner to corner. Place these on top of the red and peach 4" squares and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the line on both sides. Cut along the center line. Press the red/white HST to the red, and press the peach/white HST to the white. Square up HST's to  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".
2. Sew the 2" x 15" strips into two sets of: dark aqua, red, light aqua, red. The width of the sets should be  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut each stratum into (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " sections. Align the ruler along the sewn lines as you cut for accuracy. These should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".
3. Sew the center red/white HST to the peach/white HST as in the illustration. Sew the centers to two of the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strip sets as in the illustration. This should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
4. Sew the peach/white HST's to the ends of the remaining strip sets, aligning them as in the illustration. Sew these to the center blocks. The block is  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
