## BLOCK 6: "Contribution" Block Heads 3 Moda Fabrics Block 20

## Cutting Instructions:

From red, cut (8) 2 " squares and (2) $41 / 22^{\prime}$ squares.
From dark aqua, cut (8) 4" squares.
From light aqua, (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Already marked with Quick Step HST lines.
From light blue, (2) $71 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " squares.
Dark yellow, (8) $2 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares, (1) $31 / 2 \prime \times 18$ " strips.
Light yellow, (2) 3 ½" squares.

## Construction:

1. Construct the dark yellow/light aqua HST using the Quick Step ruler method. The lines are already marked on the light aqua strip. Place it on top of the dark yellow $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ strip and sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the slanted lines. Cut on all drawn lines. Square them up to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
2. Construct the dark yellow/red and the dark aqua/light blue Flying Geese (FG) blocks using the "Four-at-a-time" method. Square the aqua/blue blocks to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Square the dark yellow/red FG to $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make sure that the point is $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the edge of the block.
3. Complete the construction of the $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block, starting at step 13 on page 3 of the Moda Fabrics handout.
